- 1) **H.R. 126** – To amend Public Law 89-366 to allow for an adjustment in the number of free roaming horses permitted in Cape Lookout National Seashore (*Rep. Jones (NC) – Resources*)
- 2) **H.R. 186** – Llagas Reclamation Groundwater Remediation Initiative (*Rep. Pombo – Resources*)
- 3) **H.R. 584** – Gateway Communities Cooperation Act (*Rep. Pombo – Resources*)
- 4) **H.R. 486** – To provide for a land exchange involving private land and Bureau of Land Management land in the vicinity of Holloman Air Force Base, New Mexico, for the purpose of removing private land from the required safety zone surrounding munitions storage bunkers at Holloman Air Force Base (*Rep. Pearce – Resources*)
- 5) **H.R. 680** – To direct the Secretary of Interior to convey certain land held in trust for the Paiute Indian Tribe of Utah to the City of Richfield, Utah (*Rep. Cannon – Resources*)
- 6) **H.R. 816** – Nevada National Forest Land Disposal Act of 2005 (*Rep. Gibbons – Resources*)
- 7) **H.R. 62** – To create the Office of Chief Financial Officer of the Government of the Virgin Islands (*Rep. Christensen – Resources*)
- 8) **H.R. 412** – Western Reserve Heritage Areas Study Act (*Rep. Ryan {OH} – Resources*)
- 9) **H.R. 694** – Gullah/Geechee Cultural Heritage Act (*Rep. Clyburn – Resources*)
