### Suspensions (6 bills):

- 1) [H.J.Res. 81](#) – Providing for the appointment of Phillip Frost as a citizen regent of the Board of Regents of the Smithsonian Institution (*Rep. Regula – House Administration*)
- 2) [H.J.Res. 82](#) – Providing for the reappointment of Alan G. Spoon as a citizen regent of the Board of Regents of the Smithsonian Institution (*Rep. Regula – House Administration*)
- 3) [H.Con.Res. 355](#) – Recognizing the benefits and importance of school-based music education, and for other purposes (*Rep. Cooper – Education and the Workforce*)
- 4) [H.Res. 703](#) – Recognizing the 20th anniversary of the Chernobyl nuclear disaster and supporting continued efforts to control radiation and mitigate the adverse health consequences related to the Chernobyl nuclear power plant (*Rep. Gallegly – International Relations*)
- 5) [H.Res. 744](#) – Expressing support for the Good Friday Agreement of 1998 as the blueprint for lasting peace in Northern Ireland and support for continued police reform in Northern Ireland as a critical element in the peace process (*Rep. Hyde – International Relations*)
- 6) [H.Res. 692](#) – Commending the people of the Republic of the Marshall Islands for the contributions and sacrifices they made to the United States nuclear testing program in the Marshall Islands, solemnly acknowledging the first detonation of a hydrogen bomb by the United States on March 1, 1954, on the Bikini Atoll in the Marshall Islands, and remembering that 60 years ago the United States began its nuclear testing program in the Marshall Islands (*Del. Faleomavaega – International Relations*)
